(Ann. Chemie, 239, 4) and J. H. Long s report of 131C. as the melting point (Jour of Amer. Chem. Soc. 21, 637). The third fraction (240-270) gave a slight yellowish liquid of a somewhat viscus nature possessing the wood smell of Hinoki. After the liquid was rectified by distillation over sodium under atmospheric pressure the chief fraction was collected between 260-270C. The oil thus separated boils mostly between 267-268C. When the fraction is dissolved in a little glacial acetic acid and is shaken with a few drops of concentrated sulphuric acid, the liquid assumes a faint reddish...
